ORDER

On February 23, 2017, plaintiff in the above-captioned case filed a revised class action notice and opt-in form. Plaintiff shall make the following changes to the revised documents:

- The opt-in form URL appears on pages 5 and 6 of the notice and page 9 of the opt-in form. The URL should be the same in all three locations (<http://www.riskcorridorsclassaction.com/optin>) and contain no extraneous spaces. Accordingly, on page 5 of the notice and page 9 of the opt-in form, the extraneous spaces after the first and third forward slashes should be removed. In addition, on page 6 of the notice, “http://” should be added at the beginning of the URL and the extraneous space between the forward slash and “optin” should be removed.
- The bulleted sentence underneath the opt-in form URL that appears on page 5 of the notice and page 9 of the opt-in form should be changed to: “A copy of the Class Action Opt-In Notice Form may also be downloaded at this URL.” In other words, “this” should be changed to “the,” “Forms” should be changed to “Form,” and a period should be added.

With the above changes, the court **APPROVES** the revised documents and **GRANTS** plaintiff’s motion for approval of its class action notice plan. Class counsel shall distribute the notice to the potential class members by **no later than Wednesday, March 15, 2017**. Potential class members shall be required to return their opt-in forms by **no later than sixty days after the date of the notice**. Class counsel shall “certify final membership in the Class by identifying the name of each member of the Class to the Court and providing to the Court and Defendant a copy of the

opt-in form completed by each Class member and submitted to Class counsel" by **no later than thirty days after the deadline for the submission of the opt-in forms.**
