**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

On August 17, 2018, this Court granted the parties' request to continue to hold this matter in abeyance, but ordered the parties to file a particularized status report on or before December 17, 2018. This report is in response to this Court's order.

This case concerns the applicability of certain provisions of The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 ("ACA") and its implementing regulations to Native American Tribes. *See Order, Northern Arapaho Tribe v. Burwell*, No. 14-CV-00247-SWS, Dkt. No. 41. More specifically, the case concerns whether Indian tribes, such as appellant, are subject to the ACA's large employer shared responsibility provision, 26 U.S.C. § 4980H.

On May 23, 2018, Senator Steve Daines introduced legislation that would expressly exclude Indian Tribes from the definition of "large employer" under § 4980H, retroactive to December 31, 2014. The bill remains pending in the Senate.

Accordingly, the parties respectfully request that the Court continue to hold this appeal in abeyance, with a status report due in sixty (60) days, so as to provide Congress with additional time to act.
