DEFENDANTS' NOTICE TO THE COURT OF RESTORATION OF APPROPRIATIONS

On January 14, 2019, this Court granted Defendants' motion to stay the Court's Order (ECF No. 134) directing the parties to file a joint status report by January 9, 2019, in the above-captioned case, and relieved Defendants from "relevant deadlines until operational funding for the Department of Justice is restored." *See* Order, ECF No. 127. As of January 25, 2019, funding was restored through February 15, 2019, for the Department of Justice and the Internal Revenue Service, and the Department resumed its usual civil litigation functions. Pursuant to the Court's order, the deadline for filing a joint status report was extended to "seven days"

[following] the Department of Justice regaining operational funding." Accordingly, Defendants now intend to confer with Plaintiffs and file a joint status report on or before February 1, 2019.
