## PAUL A. ENGELMAYER, District Judge:

The Court has accepted as related to 19 Civ. 4676 the following two newly filed cases:

(1) 19 Civ. 5433, *Planned Parenthood Federation of America, Inc., et al. v. Azar II, et al.*; and

(2) 19 Civ. 5435, *National Family Planning and Reproductive Health Association, et al. v. Azar, et al.* As counsel in the newly filed cases are surely aware, the Court has set a schedule in 19

Civ. 4676 for an anticipated preliminary injunction. Dkt. 27. To the extent that plaintiffs in a related case seek to join that motion, or to move independently for a preliminary injunction, they are to file a letter forthwith on the docket of the case reflecting such an intention.

In anticipation of the July 22, 2019 effective date of the rule that plaintiffs in all three cases challenge, and to facilitate litigation on a common schedule of any such motions for preliminary relief, the Court hereby sets the following schedule for any preliminary injunction motion that may be filed in the two related cases. Such motions and accompanying memoranda of law will be due 5 p.m. on Monday, June 17, 2019. (That deadline is three days after the deadline the Court has set for the plaintiffs in 19 Civ. 4676 to file such a motion, which deadline remains in place for the 19 Civ. 4676 plaintiffs.) The Government's opposition to any preliminary injunction motion remains due on June 28, 2019. A reply, if any, by plaintiffs in any

of these three cases is—and with respect to 19 Civ. 4676, remains—due on July 5, 2019. The Court will hear argument as to any preliminary injunction motions together, on Friday, July 12, 2019 at 2:00 p.m.
