## **ORDER**

Before the Court is the parties' Joint Status Report Regarding Proposed Schedule ("Joint Report") (ECF No. 18), filed February 13, 2020. After considering the Joint Report, the Court finds that Defendants' proposed schedule would best serve both judicial economy and the interests of the parties. Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that:

- 1. There will be no discovery conducted by either party.
- 2. Defendants' obligation to answer the First Amended Complaint is suspended pending further order of the Court.
- 3. Plaintiffs shall file their Motion for Summary Judgment on or before **February 19, 2020**.
- 4. Defendants shall file a combined brief, not to exceed fifty pages, containing their opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, their opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment, and their memorandum in support of Defendants' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment on or before March 9, 2020.
- 5. Plaintiff shall file a combined brief, not to exceed fifty pages, containing their reply in support of their Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction, their reply in support of their Motion for Summary Judgment, and their opposition to Defendants' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment on or before April 6, 2020.
- 6. Defendants shall file their reply in support of their Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment on or before April 24, 2020.

7. A hearing on the pending motions will be held on a date to be determined in the Second Floor Courtroom of the Eldon B. Mahon Courthouse. Counsel for both parties are directed to attend.
