## DECLARATION OF JASON SCHWARTZ IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT

- I, Jason Schwartz, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declare as follows:
  - 1. I am a plaintiff in the above-captioned lawsuit.
  - 2. I am a 46-year-old locksmith employed by Yale University, and I am member of UNITE HERE Local 35.
  - 3. My wife and I are insured by Yale's group health plan, Aetna Select.
  - 4. I have not complied with the Health Expectations Program ("HEP") because my health privacy is very important to me, and I am very concerned about providing my health data as part of the HEP. I also believe that Yale does not have the right to interfere with my own health care decisions, made with my doctor, and force me to get the procedures they have decided I need on their schedule.

5. Because I am not in compliance with the HEP, Yale has deducted \$25 per week from my paycheck since approximately February 2019. This weekly deduction has impacted my many other financial responsibilities.
