ORDER CONTINUING STAY

On June 26, 2018, the Court issued an Order staying this case and directing the parties to file a Joint Status Report within fifteen days of a final judgment in *Moda Health Plan, Inc. v. United States*, No. 18-1028, and *Land of Lincoln Mutual Health Insurance Co. v. United States*, No. 18-1038. *See generally* Order Staying Case, ECF No. 16. Pursuant to that Order, on May 12, 2020, defendant filed a Joint Status Report, informing the Court that, on April 27, 2020, the Supreme Court issued its decision in *Maine Community Health Options v. United States*, No. 18-1023, 590 U.S. --- (2020), in which the Supreme Court, “[a]long with three other similar risk corridors cases, . . . reversed the judgments of the Federal Circuit and remanded the cases to that court for further proceedings consistent with the opinion.” Joint Status Report, ECF No. 17 at 1.

Defendant requests that the Court continue the stay in this case for an additional forty-five days, including defendant’s “obligation to respond to a complaint or an amended complaint upon consideration of the joint status report [that the parties] propose be due at the end of the requested 45-day period.” *Id.* at 3. Plaintiff does not oppose that request. *Id.* For good cause shown, this case remains **STAYED** for an additional forty-five days. The parties are hereby **ORDERED** to file a Joint Status Report at the conclusion of the stay, on or before **June 26, 2020**.
