ORDER

On July 8, 2020, plaintiff in the above-captioned case filed a motion for approval of its proposed class action notice plan, attaching a proposed class action notice and opt-in form. Plaintiff represents that defendant takes no position on the motion or the proposed notice.

The court has reviewed the proposed notice, opt-in form, and notice plan, and finds them to be acceptable. It therefore **GRANTS** plaintiff's motion.

In accordance with the schedule proposed by plaintiff, class counsel shall distribute the notice to the potential class members by **no later than Wednesday**, **July 29**, **2020**. Potential class members shall be required to return their opt-in forms by **no later than Monday**, **September 28**, **2020**. Class counsel shall "certify final membership in the Class by identifying the name of each member of the Class to the Court and providing to the Court and Defendant a copy of the opt-in form completed by each Class member and submitted to Class counsel" by **no later than Wednesday**, **October 28**, **2020**.
