ORDER

On August 13, 2020, the parties in the above-captioned case filed a joint motion to stay proceedings for the Dispute Subclass. They explain that they “have agreed in principle to a proposed course of action” in which the sole member of the subclass would seek approval from the Superior Court of New Jersey (the state court presiding over liquidation proceedings) “to enter a stipulation for entry of judgment with the United States in this Court” that would resolve all remaining issues. The court **GRANTS** the parties’ joint motion, **VACATES** the deadlines set forth in its July 23, 2020 order related to the Dispute Subclass, and **STAYS** proceedings for “Dispute Subclass pending the approval, drafting, and filing of the proposed stipulation.” If the parties have not already filed the proposed stipulation, they shall, by **no later than Friday, September 11, 2020**, file a joint status report providing their position(s) regarding whether the stay should be continued and a proposed schedule for further proceedings.
