ORDER DIRECTING ENTRY OF JUDGMENT

On August 14, 2020, plaintiffs filed their Complaint with this Court, seeking damages pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 18062 (section 1342 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act) for benefit year 2016. Complaint, ECF No. 1. On October 8, 2020, the parties jointly submitted a stipulation for entry of judgment in the amount of \$53,268,395.57 for Count I and requested dismissal with prejudice of the remainder of plaintiffs' Complaint. Stipulation for Entry of Judgement, ECF No. 8. Pursuant to the parties' stipulation, the Clerk is hereby **DIRECTED** to enter judgment in favor of plaintiffs in the amount of \$53,268,395.57 for Count I, and the remainder of plaintiffs' Complaint is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
