ORDER

On October 26, 2020, the parties filed a Joint Status Report, notifying the Court that the parties continue “to work diligently together to attempt agreement on a stipulation for entry of judgment on the risk corridors claims,” and requesting “15 days within which to file a stipulation for entry of judgment.” Joint Status Report at 1, ECF No. 27. The parties further suggested that, if an agreement cannot be reached and a stipulation is not filed with the Court within fifteen days, they file a Joint Status Report at that time, proposing the “next steps in this litigation.” *Id.* For good cause shown, this case remains **STAYED** for an additional fifteen days. Should the parties not file a stipulation for entry of judgment within that time, the parties are hereby **ORDERED** to file a Joint Status Report at the conclusion of the stay, on or before **November 10, 2020**.
