**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO HOLD APPEAL IN ABEYANCE**

This appeal involves a regulation issued by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) that addressed the manner in which insurers bill for coverage of certain abortion services. *See* 84 Fed. Reg. 71,674 (Dec. 27, 2019). The district court vacated the regulation. Due to the recent change in administration, there is new HHS leadership. To allow new agency officials sufficient time to become familiar with the issues in this case, the government respectfully moves to place this appeal in abeyance, with status reports due at 60-day intervals. Plaintiffs have authorized us to state that this motion is unopposed.
