## ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO STAY

For good cause shown, the parties' February 25, 2021 joint motion to stay proceedings pending resolution in existing cost sharing reduction ("CSR") cases under Section 1402 of the Affordable Care Act ("ACA") is **GRANTED**. Accordingly, the followed is ordered:

United States*, No. 20-1286 (Fed. Cir.), whichever is later. The parties shall file a joint status report proposing further proceedings in this case **within 30 days** of the expiration of the stay.
