Intervenor-Appellants the Christian Medical & Dental Associations and Dr. Regina Frost submit this letter pursuant to the Court's order dated February 5, 2021, which placed the above referenced consolidated appeals in abeyance and directed appellants to file stay status letters every 30 days. ECF No. 435. These consolidated appeals concern the validity of a final rule that the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS) promulgated in 2019. *See* Protecting Statutory Conscience Rights in Health Care, 84 Fed.
