**STATUS REPORT**

This appeal involves a regulation issued by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) that addressed the manner in which insurers bill for coverage of certain abortion services. *See* 84 Fed. Reg. 71,674 (Dec. 27, 2019). A district court vacated the regulation in related litigation. *See State of California v. HHS*, No. 20-cv000682 (N.D. Cal. July 20, 2020), *appeal pending*, No. 20-16802 (9th Cir.). Following the recent change in administration, the government moved to place this appeal in abeyance to allow new HHS agency officials sufficient time to become familiar with the issues in this case. The Court granted the government's motion and ordered it to file status reports at 60-day intervals.

HHS is working diligently to review the issues presented in this case. The government therefore respectfully requests that the Court continue to hold this appeal in abeyance, with the next status report due in 60 days.
