MOTION OF BURR & FORMAN LLP TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL TO THE ALIERA COMPANIES

Burr & Forman LLP ("Burr & Forman") hereby moves (the "Motion") pursuant to Rule 9010-2(b) of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Local Rules"), Rule 1.16(b) of the ABA Model Rules of Professional Conduct (the "ABA Rules"), and Rule 1.16(b) of the Delaware Lawyers' Rules of Professional Conduct (the "Delaware Rules") for entry of an order permitting Burr & Forman to withdraw its appearance as counsel for USA Benefits & Administrators, LLC ("USA Benefits"), Tactic Edge Solutions, LLC ("Tactic Edge"), Advevo, LLC ("Advevo") and Ensurian Agency, LLC ("Ensurian", and collectively with USA Benefits, Tactic Edge and Advevo, the "Aliera Companies"). In support of this Motion, Burr & Forman states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. On July 8, 2021 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), Sharity Ministries, Inc. f/k/a Trinity Healthshare, Inc. (the "<u>Debtor</u>") filed a voluntary petition for relief under subchapter V of chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "<u>Bankruptcy Code</u>") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Court").
- 2. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. This matter is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2). Venue

over the Debtors' chapter 11 cases and this Motion is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409 08.

3. The bases for relief requested herein are Local Rule 9010-2(b), ABA Rule 1.16(b) and Delaware Rule 1.16(b).

BASIS FOR RELIEF REQUESTED

- 4. Local Rule 9010-2(b)(ii) provides that an "attorney may withdraw an appearance for a party without the Court's permission . . . (ii) when the party (a) has no controversy pending before the Court and (b) the attorney certifies that the party consents to withdrawal of counsel.
- 5. In the present circumstance, the undersigned certifies that the Aliera Companies have consented to Burr & Forman's withdrawal as counsel. Furthermore, there is no active controversy pending before this Court to which the Aliera Companies are parties.
- 6. Notwithstanding the foregoing, out of an abundance of caution (and due to interactions with the Debtor regarding the Aliera Companies' production of documents), Burr & Forman has filed this motion in order to provide notice to all parties in interest.
- 7. Even to the extent that Court approval were required, grounds exist to permit Burr & Forman's withdrawal. Rule 61 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware provides that the Delaware Lawyer's Rule of Professional Conduct govern the conduct of members of the Bar of this State. Supr. Ct. R. 61. Delaware Rule 1.16(b) permits a lawyer to withdraw from representing a client if certain circumstances exist giving the lawyer good cause to withdrawal. Del. R. Prof. Cond. 1.16(b). ABA Rule 1.16(b) mirrors the language in Delaware 1.16(b).
- 8. Burr & Forman seeks leave from this Court to withdrawal as counsel for the Aliera Companies because Burr & Forman believes Delaware and ABA Rules 1.16(b) permits its withdrawal (e.g., "a lawyer may withdraw if "the representation will result in an unreasonable

financial burden on the lawyer or has been rendered unreasonably difficult by the client." Rule 1.16(b)(6)).

WHEREFORE, Burr and Forman respectfully request that the Court grant the relief requested herein and such other and further relief as it deems proper.
