Court being sufficiently advised, it is hereby **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. The Defendants' motion [R. 66] is GRANTED;
- 2. The stay in this matter [**R. 61**] is **LIFTED**;
- The Defendants shall have up to and including July 14, 2023, to respond to the complaint;
- 4. The Defendants shall have up to and including July 14, 2023, to file a motion to dismiss;
- The Plaintiffs shall have up to and including August 4, 2023, to respond to the Defendants' motion to dismiss; and

6. The Defendants shall have up to and including **August 18, 2023**, to file a reply in support of their motion to dismiss.
