ORDER

On May 18, 2023, counsel for the United and Kaiser Objectors (“Objectors”) filed a Motion for Leave to Appear on Behalf of Objecting Class Members. *See* ECF No. 193 (*Common Ground*); ECF No. 203 (*Health Republic*). Objectors’ Counsel requests to enter an appearance in this matter to receive copies of documents filed with respect to Class Counsel’s motion for approval of attorney’s fees. ECF No. 193 at 2. Per Rule 83.1(c) of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims, “[a] party may have only one attorney of record in a case at any one time.” Class Counsel is the Objectors’ attorney of record for purposes of the claims asserted in this case.
