- 5. Any demonstrative exhibits which either party plans to use at trial shall be shown to opposing counsel no later than 72 hours prior to trial.
- 6. Counsel, parties and witnesses appearing in Court shall dress appropriately.
- 7. Counsel are directed to notify the Court promptly of any development subsequent to the entry of this Order which would in any way affect the trial of their case by calling Jodi Wiles, Courtroom Deputy, at 904-301-6750.
- 8. All persons entering the Courthouse must present photo identification to the Court Security Officers. Although cell phones, laptop computers, and similar electronic devices generally are not permitted in the building, attorneys may bring those items with them upon presentation to the Court Security Officers of a Florida Bar card or
